
# **Car Parking**

May we please remind all car users once again the need for considerate parking and courtesy to our neighbours. In order to keep our children safe, please consider the following actions you can take to help eliminate parking issues around school:

- Car share
- Park car a short distance away and walk the rest
- 🌇 Give yourself plenty of time
- Think before you park can the emergency services get through? (if you were in need and they were delayed because they couldn't get through, how would you feel?)
- Park safely
  Park legally
  Park considerately

  Consider walking part
  of the way to school or share the
  school run with other parents ....
  ... meaning fewer cars at
  the school entrance
  ... making it safer for you
  and your children.
- Think how you would feel if someone stopped you getting on with your daily life because they had blocked you in
- Think how you would feel taking visits or calls from irate neighbours when you haven't committed any offence (myself and the school office are doing this on a regular basis)

ls your child turning 3 between 1st September 2022 and 31st December 2022?

If they are ..... did you know we offer 'Early Entitlement' places in our Nursery provision. Applications open on 14th November 2022 apply at: https://www.flintshire.gov.uk/en/Resident/Schools/Early-Entitlement-Scheme-Flintshire.aspx Children can start attending in the term following their 3rd Birthday i.e. if they are 3 in November 2022 they can start VEM Saplings in January 2023. Eligible children can attend for 2.5 hours Mon-Thurs 9am to 11:30am. If either parent works 16 or more hours a week you can claim up to 30 hours childcare through the Welsh Government Childcare Offer - apply at gov.wales/childcareoffer
