## UNIVERSAL PRIMARY FREE SCHOOL MEALS

The policy is part of the Co-operation Agreement between the Welsh Government and Plaid Cymru, which will see free school meals extended to all primary school learners over the next two years.

The rollout of Universal Primary Free School Meals will began with Reception in September 2022, and extended to Years 1 and 2 this week. The aim is for all primary school children to receive a free lunch in schools within two years.

What does this mean?

If your child is in reception, year 1 & 2 they will be able to have a free school meal everyday. Parents can pre-order their child's school lunch using the School Gateway App (download for free from your App Store).

As some of you may be aware there have been some teething problems, but this is being looked at and anyone who has been charged for a meal incorrectly on Monday 17-04-23 should receive a refund this week. This has been a fault through Newydd and Cypad and Mrs Clarke has been liaising with both to get this resolved.

If your child is in the Juniors, they may still be eligible to receive Free School Meals and funding for school essentials. It is very important to your child's school that you apply. The school can access additional funding for children who qualify for existing Free School Meals (eFSM) that will allow them to provide targeted support programmes, buy equipment and provide extra resources.
