

Frequently Asked Questions

[a] Should I help my child with their homework?

Yes, please hear them read as often as possible. It shows you value the importance of reading and offers the opportunity to discuss their book. RM Easi Maths should be completed independently.

[b] What if I have not got a device for my child to complete their homework on?

Please let the Class Teacher know and they will arrange for an alternative time or an alternative task for the pupil.

[c] How can I motivate my child to do their homework?

Finding a suitable regular time is vital, such as straight after School on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Setting up that routine makes it easier to maintain. Remind them that homework at Secondary High School is going to hugely increase in volume, so it is good to develop positive habits now. Celebrate any Certificates they bring home.

[d] Is there anything else I should be doing at home to support my child's learning?

Please like and comment on Seesaw entries. It can boost pupil motivation and create a positive Home-School link.
