

Literacy Tasks

- Read daily for 20 minutes
- Complete Lexia once a week

Complete one of the following activities each day.

- Handwriting/ Spelling session once per week; practise your handwriting for 20-30 mins, learn 5 words from the spelling list provided (look, cover, write, check)
- Over the time that you are not in school, complete a diary. At least once a week, write a detailed entry into this journal of your thoughts, feelings, actions and events.
- Read the poem 'Daffodils' by William Wordsworth. Learn at least one verse. Record yourself. Listen to yourself, try to change or improve your performance.
- Find 5 phrases that you like in the poem 'Daffodils.' Write each phrase and give reasons why you like them.
- Make a list of rhyming words in the poem 'Daffodils.' Can you spot a pattern in the rhyme?
- Think of ten signs of Spring. Find an adjective to describe each one. Challenge: Can you use alliteration?
- Write a poem about Spring. Can you make it rhyme?
- "And then my heart with pleasure fills,
And dances with the daffodils."
Write a paragraph about something that fills your heart with pleasure and makes you feel like dancing.

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
